DAILY ITINERARY

DAY 1 FLIGHT TO SALT LAKE CITY AND TRAVEL TO JACKSON, WYOMING (D)

Your adventure begins with a short flight to Salt Lake City International Airport. Upon arrival, you'll depart by motorcoach and travel north along the shore of the Great Salt Lake and through beautiful Logan Canyon. We'll stop at picturesque Bear Lake before continuing through the pastoral Star Valley and along the rugged Snake River. You'll arrive in the fun western town of Jackson and check into your hotel for a two night stay. This old cowboy town is now home to hundreds of art galleries, shops, attractions and restaurants but still maintains an old west charm. A welcome dinner at the Gun Barrel Restaurant is included this evening.

DAY 2 GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK AND JACKSON (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll set out to spend the day exploring Grand Teton National Park. You'll stop off at the National Museum of Wildlife Art before entering the park. A stop will be made at the Visitor Center, as well as places where you'll have picture perfect views of Jackson Lake and the Tetons from scenic points such as Oxbow Bend, the Snake River Overlook and more. Later, you'll return to Jackson with the afternoon and evening at your leisure to shop and dine.

DAY 3 YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK (B)

Breakfast is included again at the hotel before checking out and heading into Yellowstone National Park for another great day of sightseeing. The world's first national park is a wonderland of natural beauty and geologic oddities that has delighted visitors over 100 years. It is a mysterious land of steaming geysers, fumaroles and bubbling mud pots. A land so amazing that the first explorers to bring back tales of Yellowstone were called liars. Highlights of the day include the awe-inspiring "Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone," Upper and Lower falls, where the mighty Yellowstone River has cut its way through sheer rock to cascade down hundreds of feet to the foaming torrents below. You'll also drive through scenic Hayden Valley, famous for large herds of buffalo and other wildlife, travel the shores of Yellowstone Lake and, of course, stop off to see an eruption of the world famous Old Faithful Geyser. We'll end the day in West Yellowstone, Montana, where we'll check in to our lovely accommodations for the night. The evening is yours to check out the shops and restaurants of West Yellowstone.





DAY 4 BEAR WORLD, IDAHO FALLS AND SALT LAKE CITY (B, D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out and beginning our trek back toward Salt Lake City. You'll travel south along the west side of the Teton Range through Island Park on the famed Henry's Fork River, and if you didn't see every kind of wildlife there was to see when you were in Yellowstone, you are sure to spot it when you take a drive-through tour of Yellowstone Bear World. During your visit you will be surrounded by the free-roaming wildlife of North America including Rocky Mountain Elk, Bison, White-tail Deer, Mule Deer, Rocky Mountain Goats, Moose, and of course American Black Bear and Grizzly Bear. Next, you'll pass through fertile farmland where Idaho's famous potatoes are grown before stopping off in Idaho Falls for lunch on your own at a local brewery. Arrival into Salt Lake City scheduled for the late afternoon as we check in to our hotel for a last evening together. A special farewell dinner is planned at Rodizio Brazilian Steakhouse, located at the city's historic Trolley Square.

DAY 5 HOMEWARD BOUND (B)

After breakfast, you'll spend the morning at Temple Square where you'll have a chance to research your ancestory at Salt Lake's famous Family History Library. An afternoon flight takes you back home with photos and unforgettable memories of your time spent exploring Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks.
