## DAILY ITINERARY

### DAY 1 FLIGHT TO SAVANNAH, GEORGIA (D)

Your Southern adventure begins when you fly from Los Angeles to the Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport. Upon arrival, you'll be met by your local tour director and check in to your hotel in Savannah for a two-night stay. A welcome dinner at Paula Deen's Lady & Sons Restaurant is included.

### DAY 2 FULL DAY OF TOURING IN SAVANNAH (B, D)

After breakfast, you'll enjoy a 90-minute, fully narrated trolley tour of Savannah where you'll see all 2.2 square miles of Savannah's rich history, splendid mansions and beautiful squares. After the trolley tour, you'll visit the birthplace of Juliette Gordon Low, founder of the Girl Scouts. You'll tour this exquisite mansion with a docent to learn about the history of the Girl Scouts and its founder. For the remainder of the day, each guest will have a day pass for the Savannah Trolley so you can explore this charming Southern city at your leisure. Spend time at Riverfront Plaza, walk along historic cobblestone streets and peek inside the delightful shops that line the streets. You also won't want to miss spending some time at the City Market in downtown Savannah. Later, you'll return to the hotel to freshen up before boarding the Savannah Riverboat for a cruise and buffet dinner on the Savannah River.

### DAY 3 SAVANNAH TO CHARLESTON (B, D)

Breakfast is included again before checking out and traveling to charming Charleston, South Carolina. Upon arrival you'll take a horse drawn carriage ride through the historic district, steeped in over 300 years of history. Lunch is on your own at City Market before departing for a tour of Fort Sumter in the afternoon. A special dinner is planned in the evening at the Noisy Oyster Seafood Restaurant before checking in to your hotel in Charleston for a two-night stay.

### DAY 4 SOUTHERN PLANTATIONS (B, L, D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before traveling to Drayton Hall for a guided tour, an artifact that has survived the American Revolution, the Civil War, earthquakes, and hurricanes. Next on the itinerary is a tour of Middleton Place Plantation which is home to one of the oldest and finest landscaped gardens in America. Enjoy a low country buffet at Middleton Place before moving on to the stately Magnolia Plantation for a tour. Enjoy the Nature Train tram tour of the Plantation's diverse landscapes while guides describe plantation history and wildlife. After touring the gardens, you'll take a peek inside the Magnolia Plantation House which dates back to 1760. A special farewell dinner is included at a local restaurant in Charleston.

### DAY 5 HOMEWARD BOUND (B)

After breakfast, transfer to Charleston International Airport for your flight home.
