DAY 1 CAMBRIA CHRISTMAS MARKET (L)

The first day is packed with fun as you travel north on Highway 101 to Cambria. Stops along the way include a guided tour at Camarillo Ranch which will be decorated for Christmas and lunch at the Cold Spring Tavern, formerly a stagecoach stop in the San Marcos Pass. After checking in to the Cambria Pines Lodge for a two-night stay, you'll spend the evening at the Cambria Christmas Market which is filled with vendors, light displays, food, music and more

DAY 2 CENTRAL COAST AND CHRISTMAS AT THE CASTLE (B, L)

After breakfast at the lodge, you'll travel north along the Central Coast to Hearst Castle. There's nothing quite like the Castle at Christmastime and you'll get to see it in all it's holiday glory when you take a guided tour and see a film about the building of the Castle. Lunch is included along the Central Coast at the beautiful Ragged Point Inn, followed by a visit to Piedras Blancas beach to see the elephant seal colony. A final stop in the tiny town of Harmony includes a glassblowing demonstration and time for shopping. The evening is at your leisure back at the lodge.

DAY 3 FLAG IS UP FARM AND HOMEWARD BOUND (B, L)

You'll have a leisurely morning at the lodge to enjoy breakfast before departing and beginning the journey back home. Lunch is included in Nipomo before visiting Monty Roberts' Flag is Up Farm for an educational tourof the world class training facility.
