

OLD TOWN MUSIC HALL

Since 1968, Old Town Music Hall has been showing vintage silent and sound films, and presenting live concerts by some of the world's finest performers of jazz, ragtime, and popular music from the past. Silent films are accompanied by the Mighty Wurlitzer, a massive 1925 wind-powered



pipe organ that has been meticulously preserved so that silent classics can be experienced with live musical accompaniment, just as they did when they were first shown. After lunch, you'll take a seat in the historic theatre for an afternoon of old time entertainment including a performance on the Mighty Wurlitzer, audience sing-alongs, a short silent comedy accompanied live on the pipe organ, and a film from the Golden Age of movies.
