It may surprise some to learn that Julian once was home to an important African American community. African American, Fred Coleman, discovered the gold that began the rush to Julian in 1870. Albert and Margaret Robinson built and ran the Hotel Robinson, frequented by many prominent citizens of the time. America Newton, a black washer woman who homesteaded 80 acres west of town, became a local celebrity and a stretch of road leading to town has been known ever since as America Grade. You'll be joined by a knowledgeable historian who will introduce you to this unique story of Julian's past and the influence that African Americans had here. Having grown up all his life in Julian as a fourth generation Julian resident, he is an expert on the subject and a captivating storyteller.
